

- 9 Directions


Missions of the Grants and Partnerships Department

Building city (EU) funding strategy: step-by-step




Territorial Diagnosis : participatory approach

A resolutely participative approach

- Steering Committee (validation of main steps)
- Exploratory interviews (7 interviews)
- Exploratory participatory workshop (15 participants)
- In-depth interviews for the diagnostic phase & feedback (38 interviews)
- Final workshop (30 participants)

In total:

- 56 involved participants from different administrative level
- Participatory tools (Google Share/Zoom)



Challenges & Enabling conditions


- Enabling conditions:
 - Political and Administrative Support
 - One dedicated person in charge of strategy implementation
 - Weekly and steady progress of the strategy implementation with Line Manager
 - Dedicated budget (travelling, networks etc.)
 - Added value of project for the administration and the project managers
- Challenges:
 - Ensure the link between EU opportunity and limited administration resources
 - Cofinancing and Budget constraints
 - Maintaining level of engagement (continuous process)
 - Demystifying EU project application processes (from sensibilisation, to networking and capacity building and project management)

Transfer tips

- Start from enabling conditions
 - Weekly and steady progress of the strategy implementation with Line Manager
 - Make sure there is alignment between project idea and workload of project managers
- Look for ambassadors
- Reiterative process
- Baby steps (and patience!)
