

# The European Urban Initiative (EUI)

- ➤ The European Urban Initiative (EUI) is an EU instrument managed by the European Commission's Directorate-General for Regional and Urban Policy (DG REGIO)
- The EUI has a total budget of €450 million from the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) for the 2021–2027 programming period
- > The EUI supports cities of all sizes, to build capacity and knowledge, to support innovation and develop transferable and scalable innovative solutions to urban challenges of EU relevance
- > The EUI consolidates initiatives from the previous programming period:
  - ✓ Integrates and continues the Urban Innovative Actions (UIA)
  - ✓ Incorporates the functions of the **Urban Development Network (UDN)**
  - ✓ Directly supports the implementation of the **Urban Agenda for the EU**











- > The EUI is structured around **three key strands**:
  - ✓ Innovative Actions
  - Capacity Building
  - Knowledge & Communication

By combining these strands, the EUI represents the most comprehensive framework for supporting urban innovation across the EU, offering direct funding, technical support, and knowledge-sharing to cities

Our final goal: sustainable urban development in Europe!






### **Innovative Actions**

- ➤ To date, **4 projects led by Portuguese urban authorities** have been approved under the first three calls for Innovative Actions. These projects reflect a broad thematic and institutional diversity:
  - ✓ Blue innovation and social inclusion in Viana do Castelo
  - ✓ Sustainable tourism powered by artificial intelligence in Coimbra
  - ✓ Climate resilience and sustainable urban agriculture in Câmara de Lobos
  - ✓ **Digital transformation of public services and citizen participation** in *Matosinhos*Each of these projects functions as a **real-world innovation laboratory**, contributing to the design of replicable solutions with European added value
  - > The next call (Call 4) is expected in early 2026, with detailed information on thematic priorities and selection criteria to be made available from November 2025. An information session is also foreseen for that period, to present the rules and strategic framing of the call









### **Capacity Building**

City-to-city exchanges

Bring together an urban authority facing an implementation challenge, and another one or two, who can help tackling this challenge with experience

Peer reviews

Art. 11 and Art. 7 Cities review their SUD strategies and get recommendations from peers during a 2day event. Experts guide cities during the whole process

### **Capacity Building**

- This support also targets cities that are not yet active in European initiatives, encouraging their gradual integration into cooperation and mutual learning mechanisms
- > These opportunities are available **throughout the year**, notably the **City-to-City Exchanges call**, which remains **permanently open**
- > Several **capacity-building and knowledge-sharing activities** are already scheduled between June and December 2025, including:
  - ✓ **Policy Lab on Access to Funding** 30 September to 2 October
  - ✓ EU City Lab on Active Mobility week of 27 October
  - ✓ Policy Lab on Affordable Housing 18 to 20 November
- ➤ The next Peer Review call will be launched in autumn 2025, with structured technical support available for urban authorities interested in applying














### **Knowledge & Communication**

- Ambition: to consolidate and disseminate useful knowledge to support the design of urban public policies and improve the quality of programming within the cohesion policy framework
- > This dimension encompasses several **complementary tools and actions** aimed at strengthening the knowledge base for sustainable urban development across the EU. This includes:
  - ✓ The **online platform** 'PORTICO', for the collection and dissemination of knowledge from innovative practices, providing information and support to cities to strengthen urban policies across Europe
  - ✓ The **production and systematization of evidence** on sustainable urban development
  - ✓ The network of national Urban Contact Points (UCPs)






- Implementation of the European Network of Urban Contact Points (UCPs) for the European Urban Initiative:


