What is IURC?


- An EU-funded programme, the International Urban and Regional Cooperation (IURC) aims to lead decentralized subnational cooperation in the fields of sustainable urban development and regional innovation.
- It brings together **cities** and **regions** from the EU, Asia, Australasia and the Americas.
- Focuses not only on developing partnerships, but also on practical implementation of concrete projects.
- A pathway to connect governments, businesses, research institutions and civil society (quadruple-helix) to get together and make a difference for the future through their actions.







- Strategic Sectors: Sustainable tourism, cultural heritage preservation, legacy of mega events

- Circular Economy: Waste and recycling; water management; waste management; construction & built environment, GIS/BIM Smart City (buildings)
- Climate Adaptation, Nature based solutions (NBS), resilient environments, green infrastructure, biodiversity and nature protection
- **Clean Energy:** Energy transition, sustainable buildings, smart grids, bioenergy, mining, sustainable mobility.
- Blue Economy: Blue biotechnology, fisheries, aquaculture, ports and maritime transport

- **Urban Regeneration**: Revitalization of city centres, conversion of abandoned spaces (brownfield regeneration), shrinking cities, civic participation, tactical urbanism, urban prototyping, silver economy
- **Social Cohesion:** Affordable Housing, inclusive and participatory design, economic accessibility, habitability and comfort






BARCELONA (ES) & BRISBANE (AU) Urban Transformation through major events (Olympics)

- Canberra's Government (ACT) and Hamburg agreed to a staff exchange for a professional "deep dive" in technical exchange and – estimated –shared development of solutions in the field of Digital Twin:
 - Hamburg urban data specialists (<u>Hamburg State</u>
 <u>Agency for Geoinformation & Surveying LGV</u>)
 visited ACT to exchange technologies, identify gaps and solutions.
- Hamburg running an own city-Building Information
 Modelling (BIM) unit connected its specialists with the
 University of Canberra experts to share experiences and
 approaches, if possible: adapt solutions to each other.
- **Melbourne:** Hamburg experts participated in the *International Transportation Summit 2023* and discussed projects with city authorities (climate/transport/urban data).













For **Region-to-Region Cooperation**, public authorities or agencies, from EU Member States' regions

^{*}A contiguous grouping of municipalities that share some key functional services and 20 belong to the same region/province






