We bring capacity building Strengthening capacities of cities in design of sustainable urban development strategies, policies and practices in an integrated and participative way We fund Innovative actions in cities with 80% direct co-funding of up to €5M allowing the cities to experiment as testbeds for their innovative idea and to transfer it to other EU cities We share knowledge and capitalise on experiences Providing a knowledge environment for cities to ensure easier access to horizontal and thematic knowledge and share knowhow on sustainable urban development Our final goal: sustainable urban development in

A coherent support to EU cities

- Tool to support cities of all sizes, to build capacity and knowledge, to support innovation and develop transferable and scalable innovative solutions to urban challenges of EU relevance
- Building on the legacy of previous period:
 - Urban Innovative Actions,
 - The Urban Development Network,
 - ▶ Urban Agenda EU, ...
- A total ERDF budget of €395 million for 2021-2027.

3 main intervention areas

> Capacity building. Building cities' capacity for sustainable urban development

ACTIVITIES AIMED AT DISSEMINATING AND EXCHANGING KNOWLEDGE

Knowledge. Communicating, disseminating knowledge from implemented projects and further building on the lessons learnt and their experience

EUI Innovative Actions (EUI-IA)

Ambition: to foster the deployment of proof-tested urban innovations across the EU and to provide opportunities for cities, as enablers of innovation, to take the risk to turn ambitious and creative ideas into pilot projects that can be tested in real urban settings

>> Projects on **sustainable urban development**

Local pilots (experimental character, implementation aspect)

City-led, participative character (partnership led by an urban authority)



WHY innovations?


Complexity, nature and scale of urban challenges requiring going beyond traditional policies and services



Many ideas but potential solutions are not always put into practice [risks, lack of budget to pilot the ideas, cities accountable to local communities]


EUI offers an opportunity to test innovative ideas for 'real', at urban scale with all the associated risks and complexities




Call 4 in a nutshell

> Call to launch early 2026


> Total budget allocation: around **EUR 60 million ERDF**

Updated framework of support for cities



What is different

- ➤ Modified eligibility criteria for applying urban authorities: smaller cities are now eligible
- > Redefined urban innovation requirements: local innovation
- > Broader choice of the **thematic focus**
- > Smaller scale of the financed projects
 - > up to 2 million Euro per project
 - > shorter timeframe (2 years)
- Simplified financial framework




Who can apply?

- Urban Authorities above 25 000 inhabitants or a group of Urban Authorities applying together
- > We particularly encourage applications from:
 - > Small and medium-sized cities
 - Cities with limited experienced with EU funds
 - Dynamic urban authorities eager to experiment with new solutions, but with less experience in the field of innovation



- > Only open for MUA/AUA not already funded under Calls
 - 1, 2, or 3



Urban innovation requirements




new, bold, creative and experimental **in the local context**

go beyond business as usual in the city

urban solution which can be **products, services, processes**

The Call welcomes both:

- Solutions that are entirely new at the EU level
- > Solutions that have already been tested elsewhere in the EU (fully or partially), but have not yet been adopted locally (a context-specific approach)




Thematic focus

Call 4 topics will follow key proposed policy areas as planned in the Cities Agenda – such as:

- economy, competitiveness and prosperity;
- housing;
- climate action, environment and clean energy;
- mobility;
- digitalisation;
- social inclusion and equality;
- security, public safety and preparedness.

Cities Agenda to be published towards the end of 2025.

Financial framework




- Max budget per project: EUR 2 million ERDF
- ➤ ERDF co-financing rate of 80%
- Investments supported
- Advance payments & simplified costs options
- Flexibility in the forms of Project Partners contribution
